




ROSS Module Summary

User Accounts



Description

The User Accounts module is used to give personnel access to ROSS and assign them privileges within a given dispatch organization based on their role(s) in that organization.

A ROSS user may have access to multiple ROSS dispatch organizations with different privileges in each office. For example, a ROSS user may have Data Administrator privileges at their home dispatch center and Dispatcher privileges in another office while on an incident assignment. The user will have only one user name and password. An individual must have a record in the Person module before a user account can be created.

Users with Account Manager privileges use this module to create and maintain accounts for ROSS users in their dispatch center. A generic ADMIN user account is created for each dispatch center for the purpose of performing ROSS Administration functions (i.e., creating and maintaining organizations, persons, resource items, locations, aviation hazards, contracts, etc.)



ROSS Module Summary

User Accounts

This module is directly related to the Person module and has an indirect relationship to all other modules as determined by a user's privileges.

Data Information:

Data Element	Data Definition
Organization	A listing of the dispatch centers the current account manager can access.
User	The person being given access privileges to ROSS.
User Name	A unique combination of alpha / numeric characters associated with the ROSS User. Default is first initial and last name.
Password	A unique set of alpha / numeric / !@#%\$%^&*() characters associated with the ROSS User. User may change password via the File option on the menu bar.
Available Roles	ROSS functions, predefined by the Screens and Roles module, which may be assigned to a user thus giving them privileges to access various areas of the application.
Assigned Roles	The privileges given to the user when the account is established.
