

Quick fix for Brio

This document explains how to eliminate the *hijacking* of your existing browser and the pop-up Brio advertisement window each time you run reports in ROSS. Tasks include:


- To change your Internet Explorer configuration settings
- To download and save files into the WINNT folder - for Windows 2000
- To download and save files into the WINDOWS folder - for Windows XP.

To change your Internet Explorer configuration settings

Once you complete this task, Internet Explorer will create a new window each time you run a report in ROSS.

1. Start **Internet Explorer**.
2. On the **Tools** menu, click **Internet Options**.
3. On the **Internet Options** dialog box, click the **Advanced** tab.
4. Under **Settings**, click to clear the **Reuse windows for launching shortcuts** check box, and then click **OK**.
5. Restart **Internet Explorer**.

To download and save files into the WINNT folder - for Windows 2000

1. Start **Internet Explorer**.
2. In the **Address** bar, type <http://ross.nwcg.gov/> and then click the **DOWNLOAD APPLICATION** tab.
3. Right-click **bqoem.ini**, point to **Save Target As**, and then save the file in **C:\WINNT**.
4. Right-click **BlankLogo.bmp**, and then save the file in **C:\WINNT**.

To download and save files into the WINDOWS folder - for Windows XP

1. Start **Internet Explorer**.
2. In the **Address** bar, type <http://ross.nwcg.gov/> and then click the **DOWNLOAD APPLICATION** tab.
3. Right-click **bqoem.ini**, point to **Save Target As**, and then save the file in **C:\WINDOWS**.
4. Right-click **BlankLogo.bmp**, and then save the file in **C:\WINDOWS**.
