Subject: Preferred Jetport Required for Overhead Single Resources

Preferred Jetport is a required field when creating a new overhead single resource in ROSS. Jetport information is not maintained in IQCS; it is optional in IQS and it was previously optional in ROSS. As a result there are many overhead resources in ROSS that have no designated jetport. To address this issue, several changes will be implemented in version 2.6 that will help accumulate missing jetport data. **Users are encouraged to be proactive by entering missing jetport data now. The Resources files from the Data Delivery System may be used to identify overhead that have no set jetport.** This tip outlines the jetport changes being implemented in version 2.6.

Resource Item screen:

When users select an overhead single resource that has no preferred jetport data, the standard “Select Preferred Jetport” dialog will be displayed.

Master Roster screen:

When an inventory resource that has no jetport data is added to a Master Roster the jetport dialog will be displayed. NOTE: Adding Resources without jetports to positions on Assignment Rosters will still be permitted.

Fill Request dialog:

A required “Preferred Jetport” field has been added to the Fill Request dialog when filling with an overhead single resource that has no jetport information.

In each case, the selected jetport will be added to the resource item record.
