1. Search for an existing Location.
2. Create a Location.
 - a. The name of the Location is your last name.
 - b. Pick any Location Type.
 - c. Enter a Latitude and Longitude. If you don't know a Latitude and Longitude, enter LAT. 39°50' North LONG. 98°35' West.
 - d. Save the Location.
3. Edit the location you just created.
 - a. Enter the City and State of the location.
 - b. If you used the suggested coordinates above, enter Lebanon, Kansas.
 - c. Enter Navigation Instructions.
4. Select an existing location in the Location Name grid.
 - a. View the usage for that Location.
5. Remove the location you created in #2.
6. Delete the location you just removed.

UNIT 6 – LOCATIONS EXERCISE #2

1. Search for an existing Aviation Hazard.
2. Create an Aviation Hazard.
 - a. Choose an Aviation Hazard Type.
 - b. Enter the State.
 - c. Enter a Township, Range and Section. If you don't know a Township, Range and Section, enter Township 10S, Range 26E, Section 7
 - d. Save the Location.
3. Edit the Aviation Hazard you just created.
 - a. Change the Section to Section 8.
 - b. Enter the Hazard Description.
 - c. Enter some documentation for the Hazard.
4. Remove the Aviation Hazard you created.
5. Delete the Aviation Hazard you created.
